All About Me!!

Intent

This half term particularly for new starters it is our intent to really explore our children`s “Cultural Capital” – Cultural Capital is the essential knowledge that children need to prepare them for future success. So, we need to know what experiences our children have had and are having, how do they learn and play, what do they know about themselves and their world? We want to look at oral hygiene and keeping themselves healthy and safe.

Implementation

We will offer a balance of child initiated and adult-led learning using continuous play and small group activities.

The theme of “All About Me” will be broken down into smaller weekly topics as below, and within these topics we shall be teaching the seven areas of learning.

Impact

For new starters by the end of this half term we would expect to know their starting point developmentally particularly in prime areas, have a good understanding of themselves as individuals, their backgrounds, and what their likes and dislikes are. For existing children we would expect them to have a deeper understanding of their place in their family and local culture, an ability to express emotions and why we have the Golden Rules, and to be able to draw on their previous knowledge of their bodies and healthy eating.

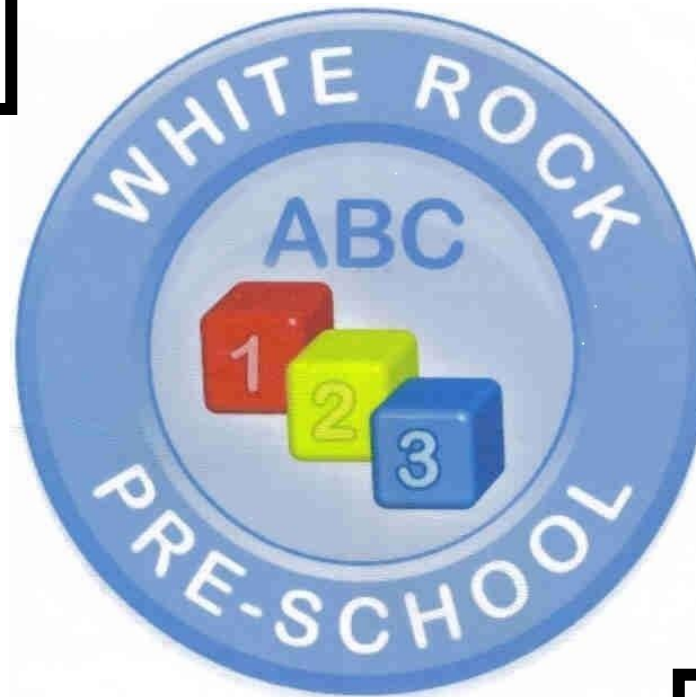
Week 1 -

Empower children to explore pre-school - How do things work and how can they own them? Keyworkers to model how to play in the different areas in an age and stage appropriate way.

Week 2 -

**Who am I? What are my likes and dislikes?
Understanding and expressing emotions.**

Introduce the Golden Rules



Weeks 6 -

Continue with healthy bodies, healthy eating and hygiene. Include an intro to "consent". Look at stranger danger and the NSPCC PANTS rule. Keeping ourselves safe.

Our Families – looking at different families. Look at Autumn.

Week 5-

How do our bodies work, keeping ourselves healthy - healthy eating / hygiene / oral hygiene. (The Gingerbread Man)
